The Information we collect may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Information that you provide to us and that includes, but is not limited to, your name, address, phone number, email address and any other contact information, school, age, graduation year, grade level, extracurricular activities, and date of birth.
- Information that we collect automatically from you and your computer and that includes, but is not limited to, your IP address, the referring URL, browser type, your computer’s operating system, your internet service provider, your geographic location, and other usage information.
- Information that you submit as part of an application.

We have implemented policies and procedures designed to safeguard your Information. We share your Information with third parties only in accordance with this policy. We require all third-party partners with whom we share your Information to make reasonable efforts to protect it. To respect the expectation of privacy held by our clients regarding confidential personal and financial information, Rightwise Prep does not share publicly certain information including, but not necessarily limited to, the following:

- Biographical information unless authorized.

- Personnel records of Rightwise Prep’s employees, and other information that might infringe on an employee’s reasonable expectation of privacy, other than information that is required to be disclosed by law.

## Use of Information

We may from time to time use your information for various purposes, including but not limited to the following:

- We may use Information for purposes including, but not limited to, contacting you regarding your interest in Rightwise Prep, providing services you request, customizing our website, improving your experience and ours, operating, administering, and improving our sites and to customize your experience and for the purpose of facilitating your transaction with the financial service provider.
